- Finalists will be required to submit a photo when requested (to be used in the presentation at the event).
- Entrants must be training a current HITO apprentice
- All HITO fee payments must be up to date.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Training and professional achievement.
- Training characteristics.
- Knowledge and relevance.
- Innovation.
- Industry support.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS (CONTINUED)

The best candidates will:

- Have a strong work ethic - this award is not just about being the most technically skilled stylist.
- Show commitment to training, setting goals and examples of how you'd contribute to your industry.
- Be ambitious, in and outside the workplace.
- Be great role models to prospective/current apprentices, people in your community and industry.
- Have the confidence to support and represent HITO.
- Indicate the importance of having an apprentice and why it's important to be qualified.
- Indicate how you have overcome obstacles.

Please note:

- Written entries must not exceed 1500 words and videos must not exceed 5 minutes.

REFERENCES

At least one reference is required. Please ensure references are from your employer, HITO Sales and Training Advisor and/or someone who knows you well.

References should reflect the qualities we're looking for in Industry Trainer of the Year, verifying statements in the application.

JUDGING PROCESS AND CRITERIA

At all stages, judges score independently of other judges:

- Stage one of judging is carried out by Industry Awards representatives. During this stage a shortlist of finalists are identified.
- Stage two of judging is carried out by hair, beauty or barbering industry representatives.
